Their "low-cost" system had a much higher operational cost, and the cycle life was nowhere near the 6000+ cycles they were promised.

This is the hidden trap. According to a [National Renewable Energy Laboratory \(NREL\)](#) analysis, battery cell quality and consistency are among the top three factors determining actual project lifespan and Levelized Cost of Energy (LCOE). LCOE is your true cost metric - it spreads all your costs (purchase, installation, operation, replacement) over the total energy the system will ever produce. A cheap cell that degrades fast skyrockets your LCOE.





The Smart Math: Tier 1 Wholesale & Total Cost of Ownership
